Examples of Supplies needed:

- Suture (2-0, 3-0 preferred) *much needed*
- Gauze
- Syringes
- Fluid bags
- Gloves (exam or sterile surgical)
- Needles (18 ga to 25 ga)
- Alcohol
- Heparin
- Surgical towels
- Drapes
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Iodine
- Absorbable pads, blankets or towels
- Bedding
- Blood collection tubes
- Cotton-tipped applicators
- Specimen cups
- Otoscope
- Ophthalmoscope
