

## NEED HELP WITH FERAL CATS?

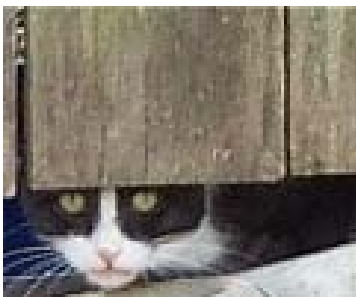
Do you know of an outside cat that is afraid of humans and keeps having, or fathering, babies? Do you want to prevent more kittens from being born into a situation where they are exposed to disease, predators and starvation? We can help!

We can assist in safely trapping and fixing feral cats, as well as providing for their basic medical needs (including vaccinations), as long as you agree to keep feeding the cats upon their return.

Since feral cats are wild and generally not able to be socialized, these animals are not adoptable and will be euthanized if taken to a shelter. These cats do not have to be put to death. Stopping the cat's breeding cycle is the humane and effective way to manage a feral population.

## THE MISSION OF CATsNAP IS:

- Improve the welfare of animals in North Central Illinois
- Reduce pet overpopulation through spaying and neutering
- Reduce the number of animals relinquished to, and often euthanized by, animal shelters
- Provide spay/neuter assistance, vaccinations and basic veterinary care for animals cared for by individuals with limited means.
- Educate the public on the care of animals through proper nutrition, shelter, and veterinary care

By spaying/neutering, we are reducing the number of cats and dogs born into situations of inadequate care and abuse. We are also limiting the numbers of unwanted animals relinquished to shelters, where they are often euthanized for lack of space.

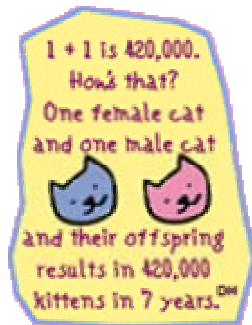
## FOSTER HOMES NEEDED!

To properly evaluate animals that come into our program, we believe it is best to place animals into a home environment. This permits us to provide potential adopters with accurate information on the animal's personality and behavior.

**Our ability to save animals from death depends vitally on the availability of foster homes.**

**Some of our adoptable animals come from municipal shelters where they faced imminent euthanasia had we not stepped forward to rescue them.**



**Adoption fees reimburse our organization for the extensive veterinary care the animals receive prior to adoption. Included in the adoption fee are:**

- Vaccination against Panleukopenia (Distemper), Rhinotracheitis, and Calicivirus [cats] or DHLPP [dogs]
- Vaccination against Rabies (if animal is over 4 months of age)
- Testing for Feline Leukemia (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) [cats] or Heartworm [dogs]
- De-worming, flea, and ear mite treatment
- Sterilization of the animal prior to adoption
- Microchipping as mandated by state law
- Comprehensive veterinary exam prior to adoption
- One month of FREE, no-obligation pet insurance through [ShelterCare.com](http://ShelterCare.com) [Adopters can sign-up online]
